TNBC Chairman's Report



Welcome to the September 2024 edition of the Chairmans Report.

Greens Lighting Update – Due to attacks on Shipping in the Suez Canal the Cargo Ship transporting our new lights has been diverted around the bottom of South Africa which will delay delivery until Mid-November. Our Contractor will install new lighting as soon as possible.

Awning Replacement Project – At the Special General Meeting on Sunday 8th September Members endorsed the Building Committees Recommendation to accept the Quote of Mick Gardiner Building Group (MGBG). Works will commence shortly and due to the nature of the works there will be some disruption to access to the Club House from the rear whilst works are underway. The Board asks Members to be patient and understanding while these works are in progress. Any concerns should be reported to the Clubs General Manager, Craig Allan.

Club Financials – Revenue continues to track strongly and we are continuing to monitor and manage our expenses so that expenditure can be kept at acceptable levels. We will need to be vigilant over the coming months to minimise impact of Building Works on Trade and ask that all members continue to support their Club during this time.

Constitution and By-Laws are available for viewing on the Clubs Website in the “About Us” area. Just go to the Menu and select “About Us” from the drop-down box and then scroll down and select as required.

Strategic Plan – The Update of the Strategic Plan is nearing completion. We are currently working on a Capital Works Program and an Asset Replacement Schedule to suit our future needs. Once completed we will make the completed Strategic Plan available to members.

Annual General Meeting – Members have been notified that the AGM and Elections will take place on Sunday 3rd November 2024. As per the new Constitution we are transitioning to Two Year Terms for our Committee Members which means this year we will be electing the President, the Treasurer and one ordinary Committee Member for a period of Two years. The Vice President, The Bowls Director, The Secretary and one ordinary Committee Member will be elected for a period of One year. Next Year the Vice President, Bowls Director, Secretary and one ordinary Committee Member Positions will be up for election again for a period of two years. All positions up for election after this will then be for a period of TWO Years.

Pennant Results

Apologies for the lack of News over the last couple of weeks this has been due to overseas holidays.

Rather than go through the results for the missing weeks below are the current standings on the ladder for each of the Divisions, along with a little perspective about the situations that all the teams find themselves in!!!

Last season was an extremely successful Pennant season for the club, and as a result, 5 of the 6 teams are actually playing at higher levels than they played at last year. This is down to two factors – the obvious being that 3 of the sides gained promotion due to winning their respective Divisions. (Men's 3 and 5 plus Ladies Division 5). However, as a by product of this success, 2 more of the sides are also competing at a higher level than last year.

Our lower two Men's sides played in Divisions 8 and 9 last year, this year they are in Divisions 6 and 8. So, the fact that virtually all the teams are still in with a chance of making the Finals is a huge achievement and we should not be too downhearted when we lose a game.

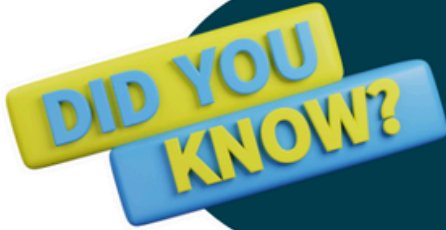

Please park in the rear car park and meet in the covered area from 9:45am. Phone the Club to book a session.

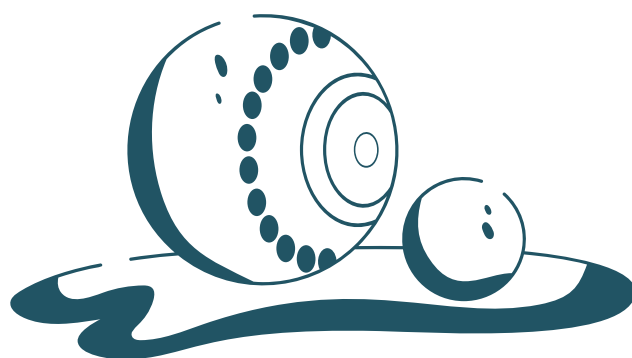

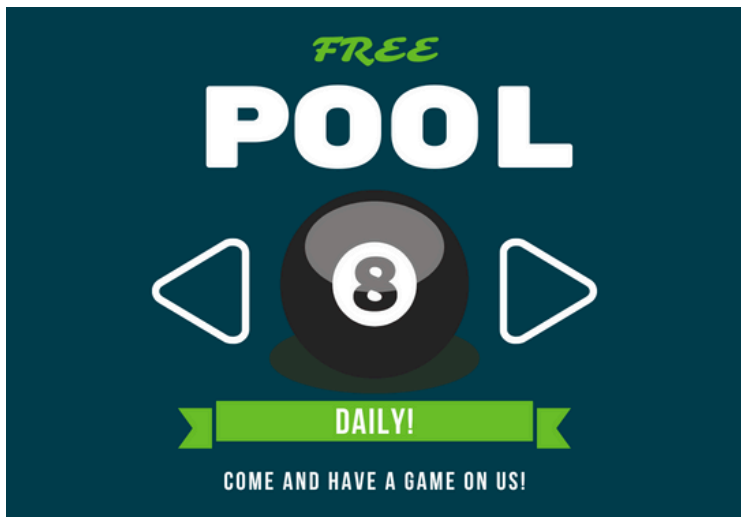
